The scholarship includes full tuition to an accredited North Carolina State supported college or university. Recipients are reviewed each year, and must maintain a “C” average to retain scholarship funding.

The Friends treat each person with compassion, and provide support to those who are greatly in need, to help meet spiritual, emotional, financial and educational assistance.
